DEVELOP HOMES FOR NATURE

- switch off external lights
- create a pond
- plant a hedge
- plant trees

GROW A GARDEN

- create a vegetable garden
- plant an orchard
 - create a sensory garden
 - plant native trees
 - grow a vertical garden
 - create a night-time pollinating garden
 - plant for different seasons
 - gather seeds to replant
 - plant a meadow
 - create a wildlife garden

To capture carbon, reduce food miles, produce food, make good use of space and provide shade and shelter. Reduce runoff, soil erosion and flooding. Improve air quality and health and wellbeing. Support biodiversity and learning.

CLIMATE ACTION PLEDGE

EASE PRESSURE ON THE WATER

- monitor the amount of water we use
- promise to turn off taps
 - check for leaks and dripping taps
 - create 'turn off' labels
 - install water butts
 - find a way to collect and reuse water
 - install a grey water harvesting system
 - plant to reduce run-off
 - install dual-flush or 'hippos' in toilet cisterns
 - convert an already soggy area into a bog garden

To conserve clean water, reduce carbon, save money and energy, support life, minimise the effect of drought and flooding.
