Map and Compass

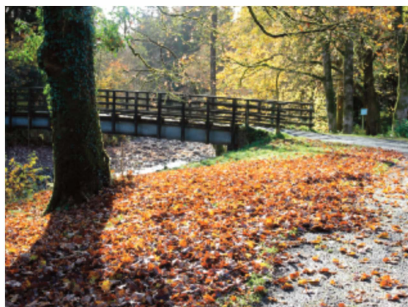
Learn navigation skills in the sheltered surroundings of the Country Park.
