

Wildflower seed bombs

A hands-on and creative way to interact with nature.

Get creative and make a beautiful gift for someone special.

Not only will these Wildflower seed bombs add a splash of colour but they'll also attract wildlife to somebody's garden.



What you will need:

A large bowl

A wooden spoon (used to measure flour and compost/soil)

Jug of water

Compost/soil

Flour

Wildflower seeds

Tray

Empty cardboard eggbox

Felt pens to decorate



Method

1. In your large bowl mix 1 part flour with 10 parts compost/soil.
2. Slowly add water and mix until the flour and compost/soil combines to form a sticky dough.
3. Roll out the mixture into small balls the size of golf balls.
4. Pour the wildflower seeds into a tray
5. Roll the sticky dough balls around in the wildflowers seeds until they are covered.
6. Leave your wildflower seed bombs on a tray for at least 2 days to dry.
7. Decorate an egg box to store your seed bombs.
8. Fill your egg box with wildflower seed bombs. These would make a lovely gift.
9. Now your wildflower seed bombs are ready to be thrown around in your garden!
